WELCOME

Greetings and love in Christ are extended to all members and guests. We trust that you will experience the warmth of Christian fellowship, the inspiration of worship, and the peace that comes from an awareness of God's presence. Pastor Gerrit Besteman will bring us God's Word this morning from Acts 2:1-4 and this evening from Psalm 5.

Today the Church worldwide celebrates Pentecost, the coming of the Holy Spirit to those first followers of Jesus Christ. Our music this morning will focus on the Holy Spirit. Some bizarre things – mighty, rushing winds (indoors!) and tongues of fire – happened that day. The organ music before and after the service will be a little "bizarre" as well. The *Chant de Paix* of 20th-century French composer Jean Langlais may not seem very peaceful; look for the moments of "peace" in the music and meditate on "... where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is peace." (2 Corinthians 3:17) And the postlude at the end of the services is by the 20th-century Dutch composer, Marius Monnikendam, and it "blows" loud and full, like a "mighty rushing wind." (Acts 2:2)
